Facts about the Sinks Canyon Center

The elevation is 5,600 feet.

LOCATION: at the foot of the Wind River Range, the Sinks Canyon Center is 150 miles (approximately 3 hours) from Grand Teton National Park and Yellowstone National Park, two of the most scenic wonders in the United States.

TRAVEL: the Sinks Canyon Center is 300 miles from Salt Lake City and almost 400 miles from Denver. These are the nearest major airports. There is at present one flight per day from Denver to Riverton (not far from the Sinks Canyon Center). Anyone traveling by air and NOT planning to fly into Riverton should plan to rent a car, and plan for the 6-hour drive from Salt Lake City or the 8-hour drive from Denver. There will be relatively few services en route.

CLIMATE: early morning, evening, and nighttime temperatures can dip into the lower 50s. Bring clothing suitable for these chilly temperatures.

FACILITIES: not self-contained. 1) dining/meeting hall is in a separate building, not joined to the sleeping cabins 2) sleeping cabins are separate from the bathrooms/shower houses 3) sleeping cabins require a slight uphill walk, on mostly paved footpaths, from the dining/meeting hall. Cabins are near the bathrooms/shower houses. Due to the elevation, slight uphill walking could be difficult for anyone with heart or lung trouble.

FOOD: vegetarian fare, including vegan, can be provided. Red meat, poultry, and fish will also be served. Special diets can probably also be accommodated. A microwave oven plus a family-style refrigerator/freezer will be available, as well as electrical outlets and space for a limited number of small appliances.
